Introduction

The doctor-patient ratio is still far from adequate in this country of more than 160 million people. Along with the government initiative, private entrepreneurs have come forward to establish medical colleges and hospitals. The private sector has already made commendable progress in this field. Government of Bangladesh has rightly laid down some strict criterias, principles and guidelines to standardize the private medical colleges.

Enam Medical College was established in 2003, fulfilling all the criteria set by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council and University of Dhaka. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare of the Government of People's Republic of Bangladesh and University of Dhaka permitted Enam Medical College for admission of 50 students in first year MBBS course during the session 2003-2004. Now the admission capacity is 155. The College is **affiliated with University of Dhaka and is recognized by Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BMDC)**. Training in Enam Medical College Hospital is recognized by Bangladesh College of Physicians and Surgeons (BCPS). Enam Medical College is also in the recognition list of International Medical Schools through FAIMER, AVISINA and IMED.

Goals and Objectives

Enam Medical College & Hospital has been designed to provide broad-based education and professional development for students. The academic faculty is highly qualified. The attached hospital is well-equipped with modern, standard and updated facilities. All these will help the students to gain knowledge, skill and attitude to deal with the health problems of the community and make their basics sound to face the challenges in their professional life.

Campus and Location

Enam Medical College is located at 9/3 Parboti Nagar, Bir Muktijoddha Abul Kashem Sandeep Sarak (Thana Road), Savar, Dhaka, Bangladesh. It is only about 15 kilometers from Gabtoli bus termial of Dhaka Metropolitan City. Savar is well-known for its scenic natural treasure of forests, beautiful lakes, small rivers and also winter guest birds. It is also famous for educational institutions like **Jahangirnagar University, Bangladesh Public Administration Training Center (BPATC), Bangladesh Krira Shikhha Protisthan or Sports Academy (BKSP), National Youth Development Training Center, Central Human Resource Development Center etc.**

Moreover, some other important installations are located in Savar. These are Jatio Sriti Shoudha, Savar Cantonment, Fantasy Kingdom, Nandan Park, EPZ, Centre for Rehabilitation for Paralyzed (CRP) and Radio Transmission Tower.

The hospital of Enam Medical Collage is housed in three unified massive 10-storied buildings on its own land and is divided into two wings. It has got wide areas of open space in front of the building for car parking and other utility purposes. The departments and wards have been set up and organized in a planned way to serve the need of a modern medical college and hospital. There is also another large building accommodating cancer hospital and five lecture galleries with modern audiovisual and sound system and outdoor, diagnostic and transfusion services. Within the campus there is a four-storied air-conditioned mosque for men and women. A separate 11-storied new Academic Bhabon with nearly two lac square feet space is located in the main campus of the institution.

Administrative Office & Departments

The administrative office and all the preclinical, paraclinical and clinical departments have been organized in a befitting manner. The departments of Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Forensic Medicine, Community Medicine, Pathology, Microbiology, Pharmacology, Medicine, Pediatrics, Psychiatry, Pulmonology, Hematology, Nephrology, Neurology, Endocrinology, Rheumatology, Dermatology, Surgery, Orthopedics, ENT, Ophthalmology, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Radiology & Imaging, Clinical Oncology, Dentistry and Physiotherapy are housed with adequate spaces with all modern facilities. The departments are well-furnished having well-equipped classrooms, dissection halls, laboratories and museums.

Lecture Galleries & Examination Halls

There are five lecture galleries and five examination halls with all modern facilities and sound system. All these are fully air-conditioned with modern audiovisual facilities. The seating arrangement is very comfortable.

Library

The college library is spacious and well-furnished with comfortable seating arrangement and silent atmosphere. The library is fairly enriched with collection of common textbooks, reference books, important national and international journals and internet facilities including online linkage HINARI which can provide latest information of progress in the field of medical science. It has friendly open stack and easy access system. The library remains open from 8 AM to 10 PM on all working days. The library remains closed on Fridays and national holidays. A huge duplex library including two top floors of academic bhaban will be launched very soon.

Hostel

Separate hostel accommodation for both male and female students with good facilities are available within the campus.

Enam Cafeteria

Enam Medical College has a high quality modern cafeteria with a hygienic live kitchen. The cafeteria is located in the college building. All types of fast foods, bakery items, and indian, thai, chinese and bangladeshi foods are available at affordable prices. It has two separate lounges for teachers and students. Students can eat or drink on daily basis.

Admission into MBBS Course

Admission is on the basis of merit. Criteria prescribed by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and BMDC are followed. Applications are invited by the Director, Medical Education, Government of Bangladesh. The admission test is organized and conducted by the Director, Medical Education both for government and private medical colleges.

Eligibility

Candidates passing HSC or equivalent examination in science group with Physics, Chemistry and Biology during last two years from any recognized board or University of Bangladesh and passing SSC or equivalent examination in science group in previous two years and obtaining total GPA 9 and with minimum GPA 3.5 in Biology in HSC are eligible to apply.

Those who have passed 'O' and 'A' level or equivalent examinations in the specified years having equivalent marks are also eligible to apply with an equivalence certificate from Director, Medical Education, Mohakhali, Dhaka.

Application Procedure

Applications are to be submitted to a government medical college as per advertisement by Director, Medical Education. The admission test is held on same date and time for both government and private medical colleges.

Selection of Candidates

Separate list is published by Director, Medical Education from the candidates for admission into private medical colleges. List of finally eligible candidates is duly notified through website or daily news papers by Director, Medical Education. The candidates from this list will be eligible to apply for admission into Enam Medical College or other private medical colleges according to their choice. Final selection for admission will be made on the basis of national merit position.

Medical Examination

The selected candidates will be examined by a medical board for their physical fitness. The medical board will be formed by the Principal of Enam Medical College.

College Administration

Principal of Enam Medical College along with Vice Principal and Academic Council will look after the administration, manpower management and implementation of educational programs. Heads of all departments, Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors, Lecturers, Registrars, Assistant Registrars, Medical Officers and concerned staffs help the Principal to implement academic programs and maintain academic atmosphere of the college.

Conduct and Discipline

All students must abide by all the rules and regulations of the college. Disciplinary action which may range from warning to expulsion from the college will be taken for any violation of these rules and regulations. Students of Enam Medical College are forbidden to organize union, association or society other than those set up by the authority to enrich their physical, intellectual, social and ethical development. Any type of demonstration, procession or shouting in the college, hostel and hospital premises is prohibited.

Bond/Undertaking

The candidates and their parents or guardians will have to sign bonds on non-judicial stamp during admission into the college regarding terms and conditions of study, conduct and discipline of the institution.

Expenses of Study

Tuition fees and all other fees payable at the time of admission will be notified in the college notice board. All payments will have to be made in full at the time of admission. Tuition fees and hostel rent are payable within 15th of each month after which a fine of Tk. 10 for each day of delay will be charged.

All payments made at the time of admission are non-refundable and even after cancellation of admission. Any student seeking to leave the college any time after admission will have to pay an additional amount of Tk. 60,000/- (Sixty thousand) only as compensation to the College. Moreover, he or she will have to pay the remaining full tuition fees of total 5 years period.

Admission of Foreign Students

Foreign students should have minimum total GPA 7.0 in O level and A level. The marks are to be verified and approved and to get an equivalence certificate for eligibility by the office of Director Medical Education, HMPD, DGHS, Mohakhali, Dhaka on payment of fees.

They should apply in the months of September to November and to send their own foreign ministry-attested copies of mark sheets, photographs and other required papers through Embassy of Bangladesh in their countries or through their own foreign ministries. The whole admission process may be helped or handled by Education Consultancy Firms or Organizations in their own countries.

Documents to be Submitted by the Candidates

All enclosures must be attested by class-1 Government Gazetted Officer.

- a) Photocopy of SSC & HSC/Equivalent examination mark sheets/Academic transcripts
- b) Photocopy of SSC & HSC/Equivalent examination certificate/Testimonial
- c) Four copies of recent passport size colored photographs
- d) Nationality certificate from appropriate authority
- e) A result sheet of admission test
- f) Photocopy of admit card of admission test

At the time of admission the original documents are to be submitted and will be retained by the college.

Free Studentship

Free studentship is available for some financially insolvent and meritorious students. Separate applications are to be submitted for admission in this category. Five percent of the total approved seats are in the category of free studentship. College Governing Body selects the candidates for this quota.



The Lively College Campus

The long-awaited dream to start a medical college came into reality with admission of 50 students in the first batch. It was a memorable day when the classes started on 9th May 2004. New dimension has been added with the fresh admission of 50 students in the 2nd batch, 70 students in the 3rd batch, 85 students in the 4th batch and subsequently 145 students from the 13th batch in the session 2015-2016. From the last session the admission capacity is 155. The campus is now fully alive, vibrant and melodious with the confident and proud steps of hundreds of meritorious young boys and girls from home and abroad. This phenomenon has added new fervor and flavor to this locality in general and Enam Medical College Campus in particular. Now the campus is ready to welcome the 21st batch students.







Academic Course

The college offers five-year MBBS course and one year internship training in Enam Medical College & Hospital as required by Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council leading to MBBS degree of the University of Dhaka. The academic session is from January each year. During the five-year course, the University of Dhaka will conduct four professional examinations.

- i) The First Professional MBBS examination (Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry) is held at the end of 1½ years.
- ii) The Second Professional MBBS examination (Pharmacology & Therapeutics and Forensic Medicine) will be held at the end of 2½ years.
- iii) The Third Professional MBBS examination (Pathology, Microbiology and Community Medicine) will be held at the end of 3½ years.
- iv) The Final Professional MBBS examination (Medicine & allied subjects, Surgery & allied subjects and Obstetrics & Gynecology) is held at the end of 5 years.

The examinations are commenced in the first week of May and November each year.

In-Course Examinations

Students are expected to maintain a consistent high standard in the academic performance. The in-course evaluations will be made through regular periodic class tests, assignments, card final and term final examinations conducted by individual departments. The term final examination includes written assessment (combination of MCQs, SBAs and short answer questions), orals, practicals/clinical including OSPE. The results are recorded in student's progress report cards/log book. Ten percent marks of each subject in the professional examinations come from scores obtained in in-course formative evaluations.

No student is allowed to sit for professional MBBS examination of the University unless he/she attends a minimum of 75% of total classes, secures at least 60% marks in term final examinations and demonstrates satisfactory attitude, behavior and conduct.

Internship Training

Students passing the Final Professional MBBS examination must undergo one year compulsory internship training as prescribed by Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council (BMDC). This training is mainly designed to develop necessary skills and attitude to deal with common health problems generally encountered in hospital and in community. This is structured and strictly supervised. The trainees will be entitled to appropriate subsistence allowance/honorarium. The internship training is compulsory and a pre-requisite for obtaining registration with Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council.

Instructions to the Students

Dress code and personal conduct of the students

1. Students have to carry EMC ID card all time during their on-campus stay and off-campus journeys for security.
2. Male students are required to wear full-sleeved, knee-long white apron in classes, wards and in hospital proceedings. Fashionable, non-professional, shabby, eye-catching sparkling clothes, cosmetics, untidy long hair and slippers are strongly discouraged in the campus.
3. Female students are advised to wear formal and gentle salwar, kamiz, hair-covering urna/scarf and shoes in accepted norms. Eye-catching sparkling clothes, cosmetics, ornaments etc are discouraged.
4. Male students are advised to come always with shoes. They are also advised to wear formal and gentle full-sleeved shirts, full pants, shoes (black or chocolate) in expected gentle manners.
5. Abstinence from classes collectively will be considered as an act of indiscipline, which might be considered as a punishable offence resulting guardian's undertaking, monetary penalty and even suspension, as decided by the academic council/disciplinary committee of the college.
6. Misconduct with fellows, peers, staff, administration and/or teachers will be considered as a serious offence and any of the above punishment can be given singularly or conjoined, depending upon the severity, state or nature of the offence.
7. Political activism, i.e., raising slogans, conducting demonstration, making procession, pasting political or objectionable posters/banners will always be considered as an act of indiscipline round the clock.
8. Students are expected to maintain the highest standard in their academic and private lives. Loss of moral and spiritual values or addiction to alcohol, drug and any sort of abusing will be considered as severe offence. Cigarette smoking in the campus is fully prohibited. Drug abuse or carrying will be considered as break of law that might be proceeded under jurisdiction in addition to the institutional punishment.
9. Mobile phone must be kept switched-off while in class or hospital duties. Students are also not allowed to take their friend(s) in the class, hospital or in campus while they are in duty or in study.
10. Any loss or damage of any college/hospital property is liable to be realized from the student who would be found responsible for the same activity.

To maintain our traditional and civic decency, institutional dignity and professional norms, students and parents are requested to abide by the rules and regulations of the college and hospital.

Student's Guidance/Counseling

To help and guide the students in academic matters, such as studies, examinations, attendance, conduct etc, students are placed under a teacher. Students are advised to meet their guide teacher. Private tuition by faculty members is not allowed. Prof. Md. Motahar Hossain Bhuiyan, Vice Principal of the college is assigned to help the students in case of any problem or need.

College Discipline

Students must observe strict discipline in the college. On disciplinary grounds the following penalties may be imposed on a student, depending on the nature of offence.

1. Warning
2. Fines
3. Expulsion from hostel temporarily or permanently
4. Deferring from appearing examinations
5. Expulsion from the college, temporarily or permanently
6. Any other punishment as suggested by academic council/disciplinary committee

Penalty/penalties imposed on a student will be recorded in his/her transcript/testimonial.

A student's name may be removed from College register under the following circumstances:

1. Remaining absent from classes for more than 3 months without any information
2. Non-payment of college dues within 3 months of due date of payment
3. Disciplinary ground (on the advice of the Academic Council)

Re-Admission

If a student's name is removed from the college register due to non-payment of dues or punishment or cancellation of studentship, he/she may be re-admitted provided he/she pays full arrear dues and a fine of Tk. 7,500/- (Seven thousand five hundred) within 3 months of removal of the name from register. If a student remains absent for more than three months but less than twelve months, he/she may be readmitted on the recommendation of the Academic Council on full payment of arrear dues plus a fine of Tk. 10,000/- (Ten thousand). If a student remains absent for more than twelve months he/she will not be admitted into the College except on special permission from the Academic Council of the College.

Code of Medical Ethics

Ethics is all about ideal human conduct and an understanding of the moral values in which actions are judged as right or wrong; and persons and institutions are judged as praiseworthy or blameworthy.

All medical decisions involve an ethical component in addition to clinical or scientific components. Major ethical issues are from increased respect for patient's right, financial restraints and new technologies.

Behind medical ethics, must stand such cardinal virtues as wisdom, justice, temperance, courage and benevolence.

A doctor is advised to use great caution in publishing discoveries. The same applies to methods of treatment whose value is not recognized by the profession.

When a doctor is called upon to give evidence or a certificate he should only state that which he or she can verify.

Duties of Doctors to the Sick

- A doctor must always bear in mind the importance of preserving human life from the time of conception until death.
- A doctor owes to his patient complete loyalty and all the resources of his science. Whenever an examination or treatment is beyond his capacity he should summon another doctor who has necessary ability.
- A doctor owes to his patient absolute secrecy which has been confided to him or which he knows because of the confidence entrusted to him.
- A doctor must give the necessary treatment in emergency unless he is assured that it can and will be given by other.

Duties of Doctors to Each Other

- A doctor ought to behave to his colleagues as he would have them behave to him.
- A doctor must not entice patients from his colleagues.
- A doctor must observe the principles of "The Declaration of Geneva" approved by the World Medical Association.

Patient's Right

The rights of the patient cover a broad range of moral and legal issues. The following rights are generally recognized world-wide as the rights of the patient:

- i) Right to privacy
- ii) Right to know about the nature of illness and treatment required
- iii) Physicians have to keep information contained in patient's record confidential unless its release is required by law
- iv) Right to have clear idea about medical bills he or she has to pay
- v) Right to have access to his or her medical records

International Code of Medical Ethics

The International Code of Medical Ethics as adopted by the World Medical Association in London in October 1949 is stated below.

Duties of Doctors in General

- A doctor must always maintain the highest standards of professional conduct.
- A doctor must not allow himself or herself to be influenced merely by motives of profit.

The following practices are deemed unethical.

- a) Any self-advertisement except those authorized by the national code of medical ethics.
- b) Taking part in any plan of medical care in which the doctor does not have professional independence.
- c) Receiving any money in connection with services rendered to a patient other than the acceptance of a proper professional fee.

Under no circumstances a doctor is permitted to do anything that would weaken the physical or mental resistance of a human being except from strictly therapeutic or prophylactic indications imposed in the interest of the patient.

Declaration of Geneva

In September 1948, the World Medical Association in Geneva adopted the following declaration which is intended to be sworn when a doctor is admitted as a member of medical profession.

I solemnly pledge myself to consecrate my life to the service of humanity.

I will give to my teachers the respect and gratitude which is their due. I will practice my profession with conscience and dignity.

The health of my patient will be my first consideration.

I will respect the secrets which are confided in me.

I will maintain by all the means the honour and noble tradition of the medical profession. My colleagues will be my brothers.

I will not permit considerations of religion, nationality, race, party politics or social standing to intervene between my duty and my patient.

Savar Rana Plaza Collapse Tragedy and the Great Humanitarian Service of Enam Medical College & Hospital

One of the great tragedies fell upon in the history of Bangladesh on 24 April 2013 at Savar Dhaka. The eight-storied Rana Plaza building collapsed at about 9 AM killing more than 1100 and injuring thousands of people. Many of them were very critically injured and required ICU life support and many others had to go for limb amputations. These types of victims were rushing like flood water in the morning of 24 April 2013 Wednesday and kept continuing for weeks.

The classes, term and class examinations were immediately suspended. All teachers and students were asked to rush to the emergency, outdoor, hospital wards and operation theater. All doctors and staffs staying outside were called in to tackle the situation.

All the patients were accommodated in the nearly 1000 bed hospital of Enam Medical College. Very effective care and treatment were given to all patients without any delay. The medicine store was made free to meet the demand. The teachers, students and staff started donating blood as soon as the news of the accident came to the hospital. Within very short time all patients were given the required management like cleaning, bandaging, infusion of saline and blood if required. Critical patients with fractures were sent to operation theatre for surgical management. Very critical and serious patients were placed at Intensive Care Unit (ICU) with life support.

Clinical students were working with doctors and preclinical students kept themselves busy in bringing new patients, carrying the stretchers, pushing trolleys and guiding the patients and their relatives to the hospital wards. Many others including the female students were carrying the dead bodies to the morgue. It was an awesome and tragic scenery all over the hospital with the agony of the patients and accompanying people.

It was really an emergency situation requiring all-out efforts to tackle. Our Chairman Dr. Md. Enamur Rahman is a man of great heart and directed everybody to do their best to save the human lives in such a critical condition.

Subsequently the Honorable Minister for Health and Family Welfare Prof. Dr. Md. Ruhul Haque along with Health Secretary, Director General of Health services and local civil surgeon visited and expressed their satisfaction and highly appreciated the role played by the Chairman, Principal, Directors, teachers, students and staffs of Enam Medical College & Hospital.

Enam Medical College & Hospital was the well-equipped tertiary care hospital nearby with sufficient beds, specialists and staffs. Later on in the next days and weeks many government ministers, high officials, dignitaries and national leaders came to Enam Medical College and expressed their sympathy for the victims. Everybody appreciated the role of Enam Medical College & Hospital.

We express our gratitude to Almighty Allah that everybody associated with Enam Medical College spontaneously rose to the occasion to meet the demand of the situation.
